Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to school! I would also like to take the opportunity to thank you for your support at the Child-Teacher-Parent (CTP) Conference held on the 25 and 26 May. It was heartening to see that more than 93% of parents have taken time amidst your busy schedules to attend the Conference. Please find important information for Term 3 below:

1. Re-opening of Term 3

All Clementians are to report to school on 26 June (Mon). Morning flag raising will be held in the hall on Mondays and Thursdays. Students are to report to their classrooms or CCA venues on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. For safety reasons, Clementians who reach school before 7.00am are to report to the school canteen and will only be allowed to proceed to their classes after 7.00am.

2. Safe Management Measures

- 2.1. We would like to remind parents and Clementians to continue exercising social responsibility. If your child/ward is unwell, he/she should seek medical attention and/or rest at home.
- 2.2. Clementians will continue to practise frequent handwashing throughout the school day and wipe-down routines like cleaning tables and shared equipment after use. Please prepare wet wipes for your child/ward to do a wipe-down of his/her table and PE equipment after use. For greater environmental sustainability, your child/ward can also bring two clean pieces of cloth for the same purpose every day.
- 2.3. Temperature-taking exercise will be conducted in **Term 3 Week 2, on 5 July 2023 (Wednesday)**. Please ensure that your child/ward **brings a working Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) to school every day**. Please replace the batteries in the ODT or buy a new one if it is not working.

4. Assessment Schedule for Primary 6

As the school aims to optimise curriculum time and encourage a culture of continuous learning rather than learning just for examinations, lessons will resume after the Year-End Assessment. This year's Year-End Assessment (YEA) will start from Term 4 Week 3. The detailed Year-End Assessment schedule will be sent out via the Parent's Gateway (PG) App by the end of Term 3.

5. **League of Champions @ CTPS**

The League of Champions is a school-based initiative with collaboration from various departments and programmes. The objective is to encourage active participation from Clementians through gamification of school experiences. Thus far, the responses from staff and Clementians have been positive and we look forward to crowning the champion classes at the end of the year!

6. **P4 SwimSafer Programme**

Swimming is an important life skill and it is part of the PE curriculum. The SwimSafer Programme for all Primary 4 Clementians will be conducted in Semester 2, 2023 during PE lessons. Four of the PE periods for the Primary 4 level are put together to support the conduct of the programme. There will be a total of 12 sessions, commencing in Term 3 Week 2. There will be no make-up lesson for Clementians who are absent for their swimming session or test. Details and schedule will be sent via Parents Gateway.

7. **National Physical Fitness Award (NAPFA) – Primary 4**

The conduct of the NAPFA Test for Primary 4 and 6 Clementians resumes in 2023. Clementians learned about the various test items in the NAPFA test and how these can be used to measure the different components of health and skills related fitness during PE lessons.

Our Primary 4 Clementians will take their NAPFA 5 stations on Friday afternoons in Term 3 Week 5 and 6. For the 1.6 km walk/run test item, it will be conducted during PE lessons or CCA sessions between Term 3 week 4 to week 8. Details and schedule will be sent via Parents Gateway nearer the dates.

8. **PE & Art After-School Programme (ASP)**

In our effort to extend students' learning of PE and Art beyond the curriculum, two modules of Sports Education Programme and one module of Art Enrichment Programme are scheduled in Term 3 for Primary 3 to Primary 5 Clementians to sign up. Each module would have 10-12 sessions that take place from 2pm to 3.30pm on Mondays, Tuesdays or Thursdays. More details will be sent via Parents Gateway in Term 3 Week 1.

9. **2023 P1 Registration Exercise – Phase 1 Registration**

Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2017 and 1 January 2018 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling currently studying in our school.

For the 2023 P1 Registration Exercise (**2023 P1 Ex**), parents who are registering their younger child under Phase 1 are to **register during the Phase 1 registration period from 4 July 2023 (Tuesday), 9am to 5 July 2023 (Wednesday), 4.30pm** through the P1 Registration Portal. The school will also be sending a notification pertaining to this on 21 June and 3 July, via Parents Gateway.
