Edusave Awards are given by the government annually to Singaporean pupils to help equalise educational opportunities and motivate pupils to excel in schools. These Singaporean pupils must have performed well or made good progress in their school work and have good conduct. The Edusave Awards for Achievement, Good Leadership & Service (EAGLES) serves to recognise pupil's leadership qualities, service to community and schools and excellence in non-academic activities. ### Eligibility and Notification of Awards

<b><i>For Whom?</i></b>	Primary 5 and 6 pupils within top 10% of each level and have good conduct.	Primary 1 to 6 pupils within top 25% of each level, have good conduct and gross household income below \$4,000 per month.	Primary 2 to 6 pupils within top 10% based on improvement in rank position in each level and have good conduct.	Primary 4 to 6 pupils who demonstrate students' leadership qualities, offer good service to community and schools, and excel in non-academic activities. Pupils must also pass the school exams and have good conduct.
<b><i>How Much?</i></b>	Top 5% - \$400 Next 5% - \$350	Primary 1 to 3 - \$200 Primary 4 to 6 - \$250	Primary 2 to 3 - \$100 Primary 4 to 6 - \$150	Primary 4 to 6 - \$150
<b><i>How is it given?</i></b>	Pupils who are eligible for the award will be notified <b>by post</b> in late November.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pupils who are nominated for the bursary will receive an application form <b>by post</b> in late November.</li> <li>• If your household income is below \$4,000, you can complete the application form and submit the form to the community centre/club nearest to your house, in early December.</li> <li>• Successful applicants will be notified <b>by post</b> in December.</li> </ul>	Pupils who are eligible for the award will be notified <b>by post</b> in mid December.	Eligible pupils will be selected by schools. Awardees will be notified <b>by post</b> in mid December.
